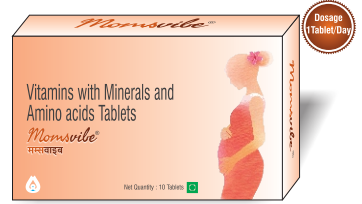

Indications

Essential nutrient supplement during Pre-conception, Pregnancy & Lactation

Dosage and Direction for use

One tablet a day. Do not exceed the recommended daily usage.

Special Precautions and Warnings

In case of diabetes, anxiety issues, heart issues or any allergies, consultation with physician before taking Momsvibe tablet is advised. Physician need to decide the dosage based on current and pre-existing medical conditions. Avoid taking antacids, dairy products and coffee, tea two hours before and after taking the capsules, as they reduce its effectiveness

Overdose

No data of overdose is currently available. Immediately consult a healthcare facility or physician in case of accidental overdose.

Drug Interactions

Concurrent use of zinc with antibiotics such as ciprofloxacin, enoxacin, norfloxacin, sparfloxacin, trovafloxacin, and grepafloxacin can reduce the efficiency of these antibiotics. Administration of N-acetyl cysteine with nitroglycerin increases it's the potency of nitroglycerin and causes significant adverse effects including headache, dizziness, and light headedness. L-arginine interacts with antihypertensive drugs such as captopril, enalapril, losartan, valsartan, diltiazem, amlodipine, hydrochlorothiazide and furosemide resulting in hypotension.

Contraindications

Should be used cautiously in patients with hepatic & renal impairment, patients with blood clotting disorder and patients with iron-overloaded states such as hereditary hemochromatosis, hemosiderosis, or have a history of hemolytic anemia.

Shelf Life

Best before 18 months from the date of manufacture. Refer product label for manufacture date.

Presentation

In a box containing 1X10 capsules.

Storage

Store in a cool & dry place, before 25°C. Protect from light and moisture. Keep out of reach of children

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
